DEADLINES: Fall Sept. 1, 2024 Spring Jan. 27, 2025 Student Name: _ Residency must be proven in order to receive any scholarship from the state of Florida including Florida Bright Futures, Florida Effective Access to Student Education (EASE) Grant, Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG), and Children and Spouses of Deceased and Disabled Veterans (CSDDV). Florida Residency Conditions: A Florida resident for tuition and financial aid purposes is a person (or a dependent person whose parent or guardian) who has established and maintained legal residence in Florida for at least twelve months prior to the start of the academic term. Residence in Florida must be a bona fide domicile, other than for educational purposes. Persons not meeting the twelve-month legal residence requirement may be classified a Florida resident if they fall within one of the limited special categories authorized by the Florida legislature and Board of Regents. All other persons are ineligible for classification as a Florida resident for tuition purposes. Student Citizenship Certification: To qualify for Florida resident financial aid programs the student must be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen. Please check one of the following. Independent: A student is independent if they are 24 or considered independent on the FAFSA. Documentation of independent status may be required if you are not 24 years of age or older.
