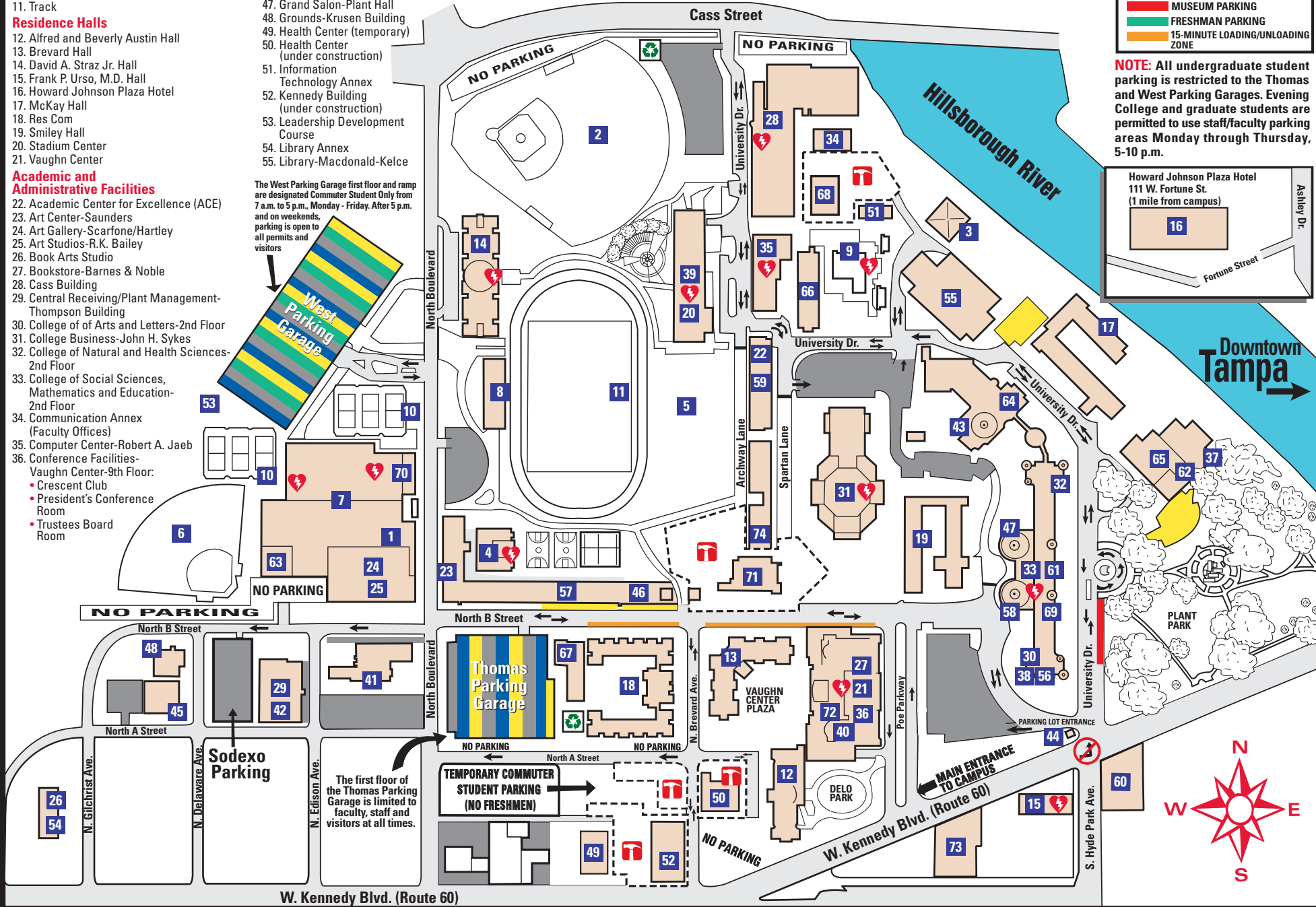
### CAMPUS PARKING KEY
