Dean Greenwood's Note



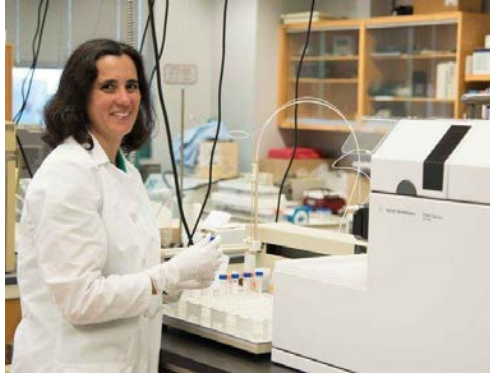
