## 4+1 M.S. in Accounting Program

*Earn both your B.S. and M.S. in five years*



Undergraduates majoring in accounting have the unique option to enroll in UT's **M.S. in Accounting** program. In an accelerated 4+1 format, students may take two graduate-level classes during their senior year and then complete the master's program in just one additional year of study. Students who are accepted into the 4+1 program will have the opportunity to obtain credits toward professional certification in a variety of specialized areas, improve their marketability and boost their career prospects.

### **CPA LICENSURE**

Most accountant and auditor positions require a CPA license, and every state requires a fifth year of education beyond the undergraduate level to qualify to be licensed as a CPA. UT accounting students can complete this requirements through the 4+1 M.S. in Accounting program.
