UT's educational leadership curriculum is directly aligned with the Florida Principal Leadership Standards and the Florida Educational Leadership Exam (FELE). Teachers may apply to the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership program or enroll as non-degree seeking students and take courses required for the Level 1 Educational Leadership State Certification.
