



## Educational Leadership Program for Florida Teachers

*Gain the credentials to become a principal or administrator*



The University of Tampa's Department of Education offers multiple convenient pathways for teachers seeking certification or a master's degree in educational leadership. Courses are available to teachers throughout Florida, and can be completed remotely or on campus.

UT's educational leadership program engages teachers in experiential tasks and learning directly aligned with the Florida Principal Leadership Standards and the Florida Educational Leadership Exam (FELE), which is required to become a principal, administrator or district-level leader.

### **UT offers Florida teachers the following options:**

- Teachers who have a master's degree in a different area and are pursuing educational leadership certification can enroll at UT as a non-degree seeking student and take courses that meet the competencies and skills required for the **Level 1 Educational Leadership State Certification**.
- Teachers interested in earning a degree in educational leadership can enroll in UT's **M.Ed. in Educational Leadership** program, which can be completed in as little as one year.

### **Benefits of UT's Educational Leadership Program:**

- Option to take classes **remotely or on campus**.
- **Flexible schedule**. All classes are held in the evenings and on weekends.
- **Accelerated** two-week summer courses; fall and spring courses are seven weeks.
- Courses are taught by experienced educational leadership practitioners and mentors.
- M.Ed. in Educational Leadership can be completed in as little as **one year**.
