Students and alumni who earned a bachelor's degree in an education area from UT are **guaranteed admission** to the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership program.

Applicants must have two years of successful teaching experience and a current teaching certificate, as well as two letters of recommendation (one from a current or most recent school administrator).

Applicants also must have a minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0. (This requirement is waived for alumni who graduated after 2017.) The application fee, résumé, personal statement and TOEFL requirements **are waived**.

Gain the credentials to become an administrator or district-level leader

Students who enroll in the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership intend to pursue a career in school administration or a leadership role within an educational setting. All courses prepare students for the Florida Educational Leadership Examination (FELE), which is a certification required to become a school leader. The program can be started in fall, spring or summer, and completed in as little as three semesters. Evening, weekend, hybrid and summer courses are offered, making the program ideal for teachers. Students gain practical experience through embedded internships every semester, and get the opportunity to network with local school leaders.
