

Effectiveness in Meeting Goal 4

The program demonstrates effectiveness in meeting this goal through intentional reinforcement of professionalism across the curriculum and through expanding opportunities for student and faculty leadership and professional engagement.

Evidence of effectiveness includes:

- Reinstatement of **class officer positions** to support student leadership and representation
- Student leadership participation through service as representatives to the **Florida Academy of Physician Assistants (FAPA)** and the **Student Academy of the American Academy of Physician Associates (SAAAPA)**
- Faculty leadership at the state, national, and military levels, including service in professional organizations
- Participation of all faculty in at least **one professional conference**
- **Two faculty publications**, supporting ongoing scholarship and professional development
- All recent graduates achieved at least **Level 3** on professionalism milestone assessments at graduation

As a newer program goal, formal tracking of community engagement and service activities is being strengthened for future reporting. The program will continue to evaluate Goal 4 through professionalism outcomes, student leadership participation, faculty professional development and scholarship, and more systematic documentation of service and community engagement activities.
