The Cuban revolutionary generals, Maximo Gomez, Rodriguez and Carillo, have met at Turk's island to arrange the progamme [program] in the coming revolution. The Spanish gunboat, Fernando Catolico, is anchored in the roads there, waiting developments. Maximo Gomez was, untill recently in Puerto Pista, where he, at the request of the Spanish authorities, received his passport. Several cases of arms have been landed at Monte Christi, a Dominican port on the north side of the island, but it is doubtful whether these are for the Cubans or for the Governor of that place. Some outbreak in Cuba is evidently expected. The gunboat Conch and the one above mentioned have been very active recently. It is though probable that those leaders will direct the revolutionary work from Turk's island or some place equally remote from the scene of the disturbance.---Fla. Herald
