CAMPUS PARKING KEY

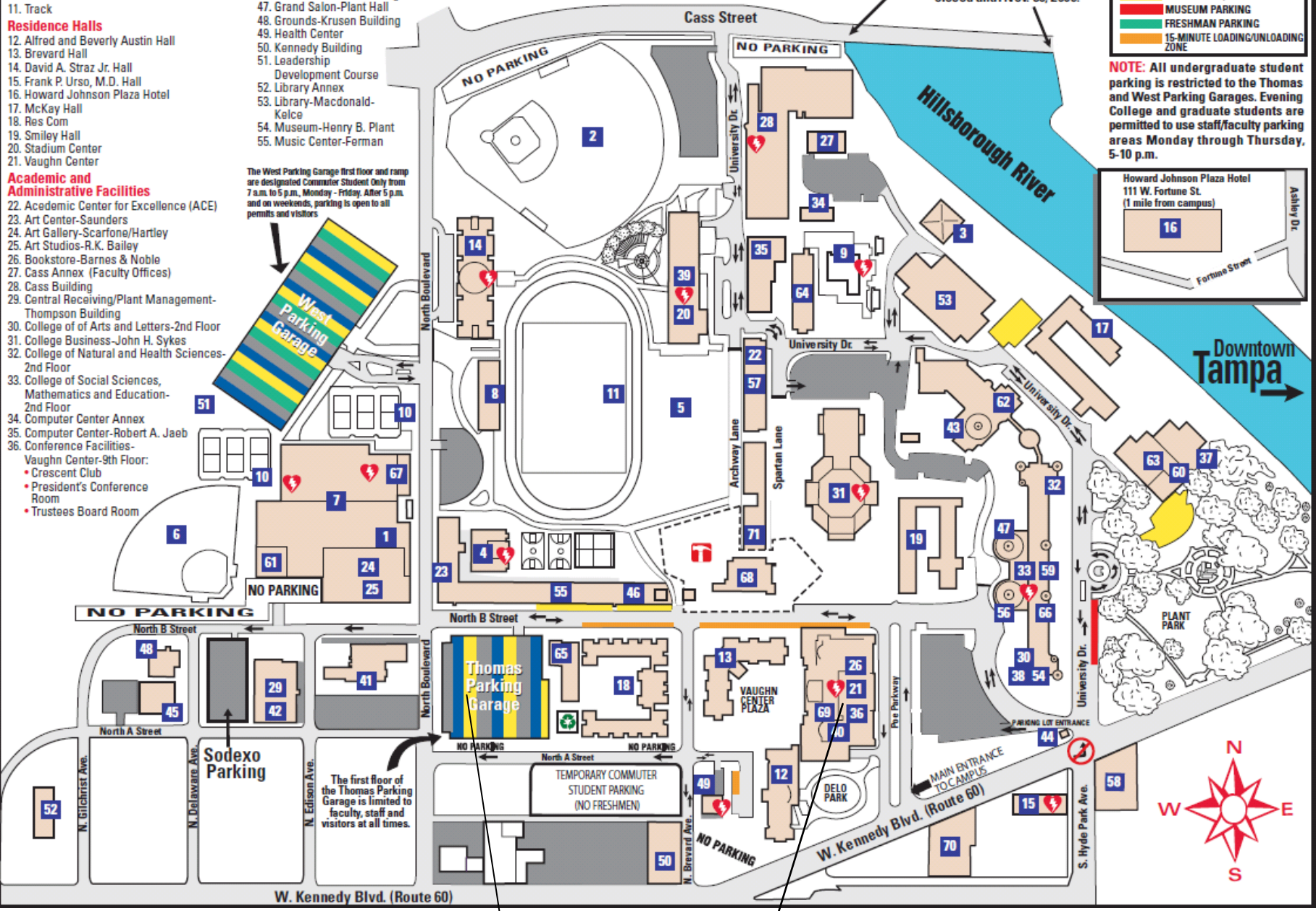
- Handicap parking is available near all campus buildings.
